- Over 1000 seventh grade pupils experienced “It Is Ok to Stay Sober” workshops in four elementary schools at Salo in 2011,2012 and 2013

- Participants were 7 adolescents at the age of 13 - 17 and their voluntary support persons
- The workshop included 3 meetings
- The goal of the workshop was to support the communication and social skills of the adolescents
- The workshops were created and led by drama director and health care students from Salo campus
